

**Eden Township Board of Supervisors**  
**Minutes of the March 8, 2021 Meeting**  
**489 Stony Hill Road, Quarryville, PA 17566**

**Call-to-Order:** Supervisor Joseph Rineer called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Attendance:** Supervisors Joseph Rineer, David Rineer and Lawrence Stoltzfus; Mark Rudy, Gerry Parker and Szilvia Troutman. Also, the following members of the public: Craig Williams, Jesse Lapp, Melvin Stoltzfus, David F. Stoltzfus, Amos Ebersol, Omar F Esh and, via telephone, Julia [...] from Lancaster Newspapers.

**Public Participation:**

Ken Johnson (228 Eden Rd) was not in attendance but previously expressed interest in joining the Rail Trail Committee. On a motion by David Rineer and seconded by Lawrence Stoltzfus, Mr. Johnson was appointed to the Eden Township Rail Trail Committee. Motion passed unanimously.

Craig Williams (Strausser Surveying) presented a centerline separation plan for Jacob S. King (930 Valley Rd) for approval and requested a plan scale waiver. On a motion by Joseph Rineer and seconded by David Rineer, the Supervisors approved the plan and granted the requested waiver. Motion carried unanimously. On a motion by Joseph Rineer and seconded by Lawrence Stoltzfus, the Supervisors approved signing the mylars outside a public meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Omar F. Esh (353 Camargo Rd) had applied for another zoning hearing and stated in the application that he would abide by the settlement agreement signed with the Township in July 2020. Since the agreement has expired and the Supervisors were not open to amending the original document, Mr. Esh will have to revise his application.

**Supervisors Meeting Minutes:** The minutes of the February 8, 2021 Supervisors meeting were reviewed. Lawrence Stoltzfus motioned, Joseph Rineer seconded to approve the minutes; motion carried unanimously.

**Treasurer's Report:** The Treasurer's report for February 2021, in the amount of \$389,111.86 (attached), was approved on a motion by Joseph Rineer and seconded by David Rineer; motion carried unanimously.

**Tax Collector's Report:** The Tax Collector's report listed activity of \$483.28 for the month of February 2021.

**Zoning Officer's Report:** The Zoning Officer's report listed activity in the amount of \$13,992.40 for the month of February 2021.
